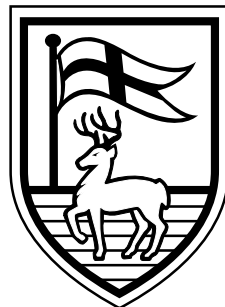

GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM

AREA I: MATHEMATICS AND NATURAL SCIENCES

- 1) Two semesters of mathematics.
 - At least one semester must be a calculus course (MA 0016, MA 0119, MA 0120, MA 0145, MA 0146, MA 0171, MA 0172, MA 0221, MA 0245, MA 0273).
- 2) Two semesters of a natural science.
 - Any two courses in biology, chemistry, or physics, as well as AY 0110, AY 0115, and PY 0261, fulfil this requirement. Psychology majors may not use PY 0261 to fulfil this requirement.

AREA II: HISTORY, AND THE SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES

- 1) Two semesters of history: HI 0010 plus one 200- or 300-level course.
 - CL 0115 and CL 0116 may be used to fulfil this requirement.
- 2) Two semesters of anthropology (except AY 0110 and AY 0115), communication (CO 0100 or CO 0130 only), economics, politics, psychology, or sociology. The two courses may be in the same department or two different departments. Also includes ED 0241 for Certificate students only.

AREA III: PHILOSOPHY, RELIGIOUS STUDIES, AND APPLIED ETHICS

- 1) Two semesters of philosophy: PH 0101 plus one 200-level course.
- 2) Two semesters of religious studies: RS 0101 plus one 200-level course.
- 3) One additional course in philosophy, religious studies, or applied ethics.

AREA IV: ENGLISH AND VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS

- 1) Three semesters of English: EN 0011, EN 0012, plus one 100-level English literature course.
 - Writing courses (ENW) do not fulfil the core literature requirement. Selected courses offering literature in translation may also fulfil this requirement; see listings under Classical Studies and Modern Language and Literatures.
- 2) Two semesters of Visual and Performing Arts.
 - One semester must be in the area of art history; film, television, and media arts history; music history; or theatre history. The other semester may be selected from any of the three-credit course offerings in visual and performing arts.

AREA V: MODERN AND CLASSICAL LANGUAGES

- 1) Two semesters at the intermediate level of any languages listed among the offerings of the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures or the Classical Studies Program.

UNDERGRADUATE REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Students with a financial or Dean of Students hold will not be able to register.
- Students need to see their faculty advisor prior to registration to discuss course selection and to receive their PIN. Your faculty advisor is listed on your degree evaluation.
- **Students are NOT excused from class to register. This includes cutting class or leaving class early.**
- Online registration will proceed by student class attribute.
 - For **full time** students, class attributes are determined by their anticipated year of graduation:

Rising Senior (ASR)	Class of 2018
Rising Junior (AJR)	Class of 2019
Rising Sophomore (ASO)	Class of 2020

- For part time matriculated students, class attributes are determined as follows, by the number of credits earned and in progress:

For example, a part time DSB student with 54 earned credits who is currently enrolled in 9 credits would be considered a junior for registration purposes, with a total of 63 credits.

- Students will register online in alphabetical groupings beginning at 10:50am on their designated day. Fall in-season varsity athletes will precede the alphabetical groupings, starting at 8:45am.
- Students will register for major, minor, core, and elective courses on their class registration day and are limited to a maximum of 20 credits.
- The online registration system will be active for each class until 11:59pm. Then the student's online registration access will be turned off until Thursday, April 27, when add/drop begins.
- There will be one day between each class registration for departments to review registrations and for students who missed their registration to register in person in the Registrar's Office.
- Most courses will be open during the online registration period. Some departments (with courses that have specific populations) may incrementally increase the maximum number of spaces in some of their courses by class.
- The University reserves the right to cancel courses for which there are insufficient registration or change time codes or professors as deemed necessary.
- If you choose to drop a class and later change your mind, or if you are removed for non-payment, you will not be guaranteed a place in the same class.

UNDERGRADUATE REGISTRATION PROCESS

Independent Study

Independent studies are available in most majors and programs in the College of Arts and Sciences. Students wishing to pursue an intensive research or other academic experience must consult first with a sponsoring faculty member.

Internships

Internships provide the opportunity for practical experience in a career field related to a student's major. Most departments and programs in the College of Arts and Sciences offer credit for internships in appropriate agencies and business firms in Fairfield, nearby communities, as well as New York City and New Haven. Majors who wish to take advantage of these opportunities should consult their department chair or program internship coordinator about eligibility requirements and other details.

New Courses

Several new courses have been approved and will be offered for the first time in Fall 2017. Course descriptions for these and all other courses are available by clicking on the course title in XE Online Registration.

Online Courses

All full-time students are eligible to enroll in one online course for the Fall 2017 semester without needing prior Dean's Office approval. First-year students may not enroll in online courses during their first semester.

- Part-time students are not restricted to one online course. Exceptions to the one-course limit for full-time students may be made only in extenuating circumstances and must be vetted through the academic dean.
- Please be aware that some online courses are condensed (only five, six, or seven weeks in duration) and therefore rigorous. Online courses often have "irregular" start and end dates (sometimes beginning at the halfway point of the semester). As with semester-long lecture-based courses, class enrollment is firmly capped, and availability may be limited.

Waitlist Courses

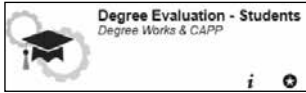
The waitlist for courses will be turned on at the beginning of online registration, except for courses with maximums that are increased incrementally.

- When a space becomes available in a class, the first student on the waitlist will be notified via their University Gmail account with instructions on how to register for the waitlisted class. They will have 24 hours from the time the email is sent to register for the class. If there is a conflict in their schedule, the student will have to resolve that issue before registering for the waitlisted class. If the student fails to register for the class by the deadline stated in the email, they will be removed from the waitlist for that class.
- The use of the waitlists and the process of notifying students will run from Thursday, April 27 through Friday, September 1. During this period, the Registrar's Office will not honor write-ins from instructors for closed courses. The electronic waitlist will be the only mechanism for filling available openings in closed courses. After September 1, students may register for classes with open seats on a first come, first served basis. During the Add/Drop period of September 5-11, the Registrar will accept write-ins from instructors for closed courses.

Degree Evaluation on the Web: Degree Works

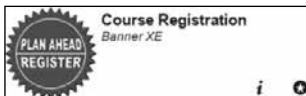


Students should print a degree evaluation and bring it with them when they meet with their advisor, or be ready to display it on their personal laptop or tablet device.

SERVICE LEARNING

FALL 2017

Service Learning is a kind of experiential education that connects classroom learning with community service. In collaboration with community organizations, students learn about and apply tools of the academic discipline and specific course concepts in their service experiences. This combination enhances academic learning and civic awareness while also providing a meaningful service to and with the community. Course credit and grading are for the learning not for the service. The service activities for the course are similar to the readings, lectures, class discussions and other assignments—all are contexts for student learning.

Courses will appear with the following notation in the right-hand column of the schedule of classes: SerL or SerL Option

SerL: All students in the course are required to participate in service learning.

SerL Option: Students have a choice to participate in service learning as a final project and/or in lieu of another comparable project.
